If you want to live on campus:

- Visit the Residence Life & Housing Services web site and review “Spring 2010 Housing” information.

If you want to live off campus:

- You still need to go to the Residence Life & Housing Services web site and review “Spring 2010 Housing” information. The “Spring 2010 Off-Campus Lottery Form” must be submitted by October 7, 2009. The results of the lottery will be available on October 14, 2009. *Do not sign a lease for off-campus housing until you receive confirmation that you have been released from on-campus housing.*

To plan for the possibility of living off campus, consider the following:

What can you afford?

Off-campus rentals are typically unfurnished and do not include utilities, so your equation for monthly cost is:

$$\text{Rent} + \text{Utilities} + \text{Furniture Rental (optional)} = \text{Total Monthly Cost}$$

Do you need to live within walking distance to campus?
